Target: 300 social innovations



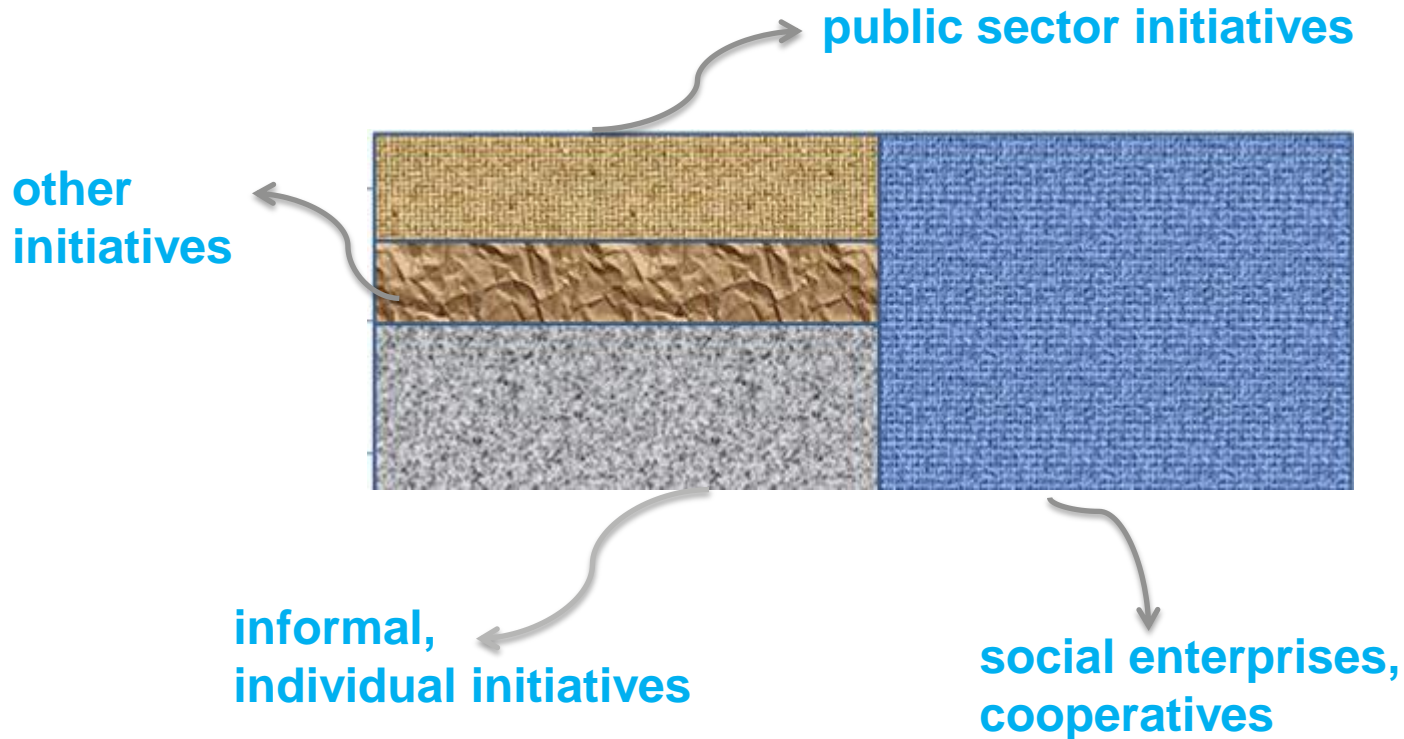
BENISI Approach

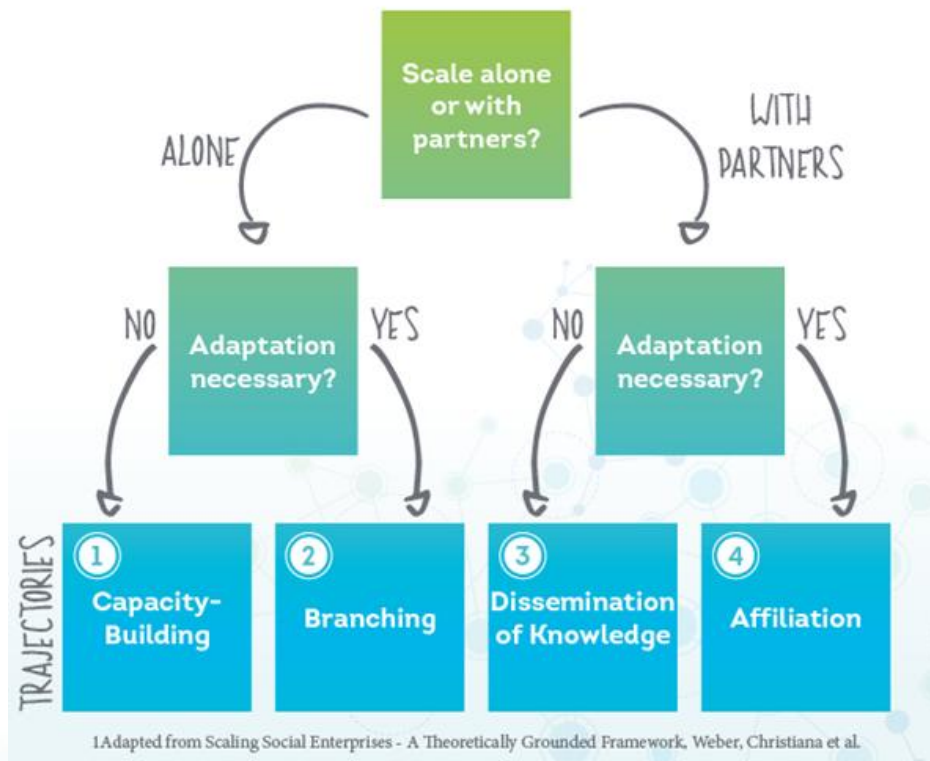

Austria, Czech Republic, Hungary, Poland, Slovakia, Slovenia, Bulgaria, Romania and Croatia

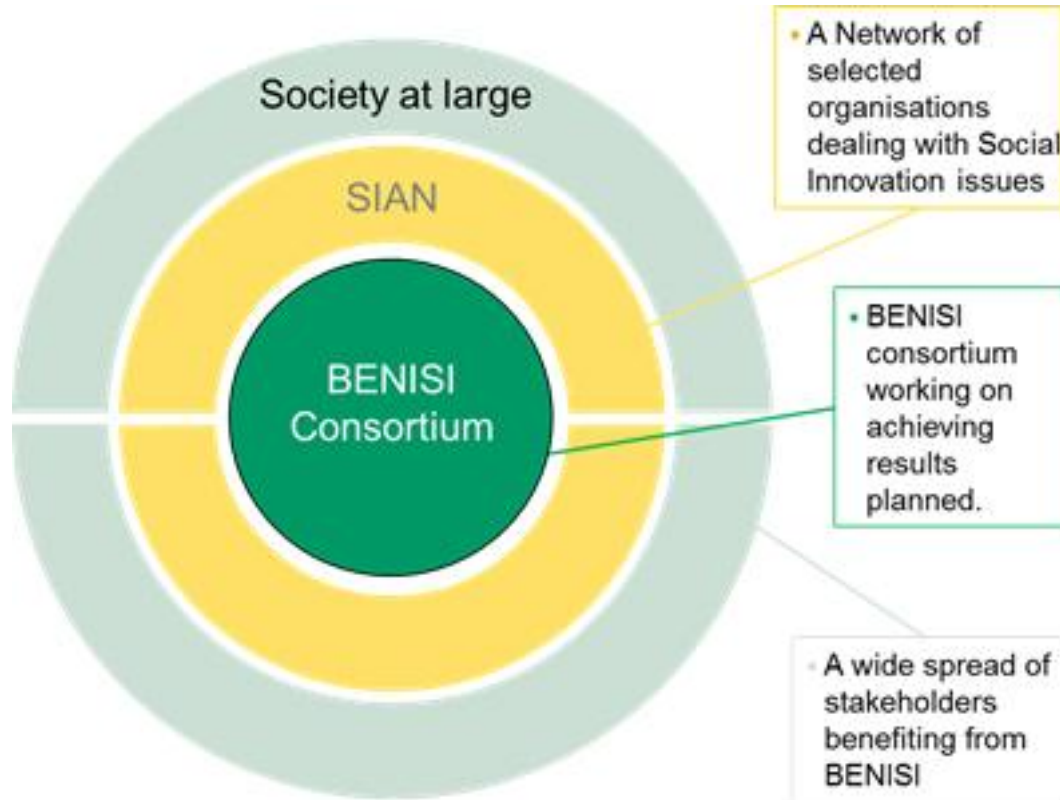

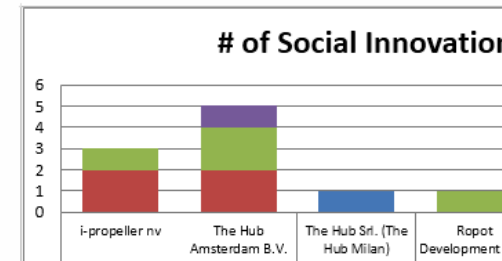

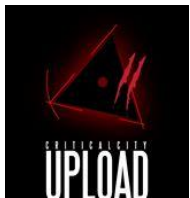
fights the raising challenge of *youth indebtedness* through innovative learning tools for financial literacy education
